



5th Grade Passport Program Application 2009-2010

Please read and fill out this application very carefully! We really want you to have your passport.

Here's what you need to do to receive a 5th Grade Passport:

1. **Important** -Include a 2x2-inch photo of yourself (a school picture works perfectly!)
2. **Write your name** on the back of the picture.
3. Print neatly, complete all sections of the form and include your phone number.
4. You and your legal guardian will need to READ and SIGN the application.
5. Include a **CHECK** payable to "5th Grade Passport Program" for **\$15.00**. This fee helps cover cost to process the application and send you your passport.

Passport Rules and Regulations. Your passport will not be valid and sent until this signed agreement is on file.

1. Ski The Northwest Rockies, a.k.a. the Inland Northwest Ski Association (INSA) and the Idaho Ski Areas Association (ISAA) is providing 5th Graders with a 5th Grade Passport (Passport). The passport is a non-transferable document which entitles the 5th Grader to whom it is issued (Holder) a complimentary student's one-day lift ticket, subject to the terms and conditions set forth below, at the following participating INSA and ISAA member resorts during the 2009-2010 ski season: 49^o North, Bogus Basin, Bald Mt, Grand Targhee, Kelly Canyon, Lost Trail, Magic Mountain, Pebble Creek, Brundage Mt, Lookout Pass, Mission Ridge, Mt. Spokane, Schweitzer Mt., Silver Mt, Sun Valley, Tamarack. All participating resorts reserve the right to withdraw from the program at any time.
2. The Passport may be used to obtain no more than three complimentary student's one-day lift tickets, at each resort, only one complimentary one-day lift ticket used per day.
3. The Passport must be presented by the 5th grader to obtain a free one-day lift ticket. The purchase of an adult ticket is not required, individual or groups of children must have adult supervision while at the ski area. If the supervising adult skis, and adult lift ticket must be purchased. Ski Areas reserve the right to withhold lift tickets if Passport holders fail to identify adult supervisor(s).
4. The Passport or lift tickets obtained with the Passport may not be transferred or sold to any other person, including family members. The passport will be immediately revoked if Holder transfers use of Passport or any lift ticket obtained with Passport to another person.
5. THE LEGAL GUARDIAN/POARENT OF THE PASSPORT HOLDER UNDERSTANDS THAT THE PASSPORT HOLDER IS UNSUPERVISED AT ALL TIMES DURING THE DAY. THE PASSPORT PROGRAM IS NOT A SKI SCHOOL LESSON PROGRAM OR DAY CARE PROGRAM.
6. The Passport will be revoked and canceled without notice for any misuse. Holders and the parent or legal guardian are responsible for proper use of the Passport at all time. In the event of Passport

misuse and cancellation, the INSA and/or the ISSA may recover damages to the Association and/or participating resorts arising from Passport misuse, including reasonable attorney fees.

7. The Ski Areas reserve the right to modify or cancel the Program and all valid Passports at any time without notice. The Ski Areas or Associations are not responsible for expenses incurred or opportunities forgone by cancellation or modification of the Program.
8. If a Passport is lost or stolen, notify the office immediately. Participating resorts will not replace or assist with lost or stolen Passports. We reserve the right to make case-by-case determinations concerning replacement of Passports.
9. All Passport Holders agree to comply with all rules and regulations of participating ski areas and with all other applicable laws and regulations, including Idaho and Washington inherent risk of skiing statutes.
10. All information in the application is subject to verification. All information in this application becomes the property of Ski the Northwest Rockies (INSA) and the ISAA (Idaho Ski Areas Association). INSA, ISAA and others may use information provided by Passport applicants.
11. We further agree to RELEASE FROM LIABILITY and to INDEMNIFY AND HOLD HARMLESS the organizers and sponsors of this program, 49^o North, Bogus Basin, Bald Mt, Grand Targhee, Kelly Canyon, Lost Trail, Magic Mountain, Pebble Creek, Brundage Mt, Lookout Pass, Mission Ridge, Mt. Spokane, Schweitzer Mt., Silver Mt, Sun Valley, Tamarack; and their owners, members, agents, insurers, landowners, affiliated companies, employees and volunteers for any damage, injury or death to myself or to any person or property, whether caused by their NEGLIGENCE or for any other reason, in any way connected with my participation in this program

We full understand the terms of the 5th Grade Passport Agreement and agree to comply with all the rules set forth above. We understand that any misuse of the Passport or ticket obtained with the Passport will result in revocation of the Passport.
